

Prof. Dr Anatoly Y. Kapustin



Prof. Dr. Anatoly Y. Kapustin is a Deputy Director of the Institute of Legislation and Comparative Law Research under the Government of the Russian Federation and a professor of International Law at the Peoples Friendship University of Russia. In 1980, he graduated from the Faculty of Economic and Law of the Peoples Friendship University, Moscow (USSR). In 1984, he defended his PhD thesis on the International Institutional and Legal aspects of Latin American economic integration. In 2001, he defended his Doctoral thesis on International legal problems of the nature and working of European Union Law.

From 1983 to 1995, Prof. Kapustin worked as an Assistant Professor at the International law Department of the Peoples Friendship University of Russia. He was the Dean of the Law Faculty of the Peoples Friendship University of Russia from 1995 to 2010 and also served as the Head of the International Law Department of the Peoples Friendship University of Russia from 2000 to 2010. He was the Head of comparative legal studies Centre of the Institute of Legislation and Comparative Law Research under the Government of the Russian Federation from November 2010 to July 2011.

Prof. Kapustin is the author of more than 250 scientific works on different problems of international public law, including the theory of international law, international institutional law, international space law, international humanitarian law, international human rights law, international security law, and European Union law. He is the President of International Law association (Russian Branch) and the member of Executive Council of International Law Association (London).
