Since 1992, the IISL has organized the Manfred Lachs Space Law Moot Court Competition. The competition is based on a hypothetical space law case, written by IISL members, in which student teams from Europe, North America, the Asia Pacific region and Africa participate. The IISL serves as official observer to the United Nations Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space (COPUOS) and organizes a variety of conferences on space law throughout the year. It publishes an annual volume of Proceedings with Eleven International Publishing.
